Human Rights Day 2016 Competition

To mark Human Rights Day in 2016, on 10th December, the National Human Rights Commission is organising a **video clip competition** on the theme recommended by the United Nations.

“Stand up for someone’s rights today”

The objective of the theme is to issue a call to people the world over to step forward for rights and to commit through their actions to the defence of human rights.

The Commission is inviting participation of young people up to the age of **25** to submit a video clip of a duration of **2-4 minutes**, recorded via smart phone through interactions with members of public on the theme.

The best three clips will be awarded prizes as follows:

1st Prize: Rs 15, 000/-, 2nd Prize: Rs 10, 000/- Consolation Prizes: Rs 5 000/-

Participants must call at the Commission in person at the address given below to submit the video clip on a CD accompanied by an explanatory of note (150 to 200 words) on the relevance of the clip to the theme **at latest by Friday 18 November 2016.** Only one entry per person will be accepted.

Modalities of participation

Theme: “Stand up for someone’s rights today”

Participants should be students of up to 25 years.

The Video clip should be recorded through smart phone and submitted on CD together with an explanatory note on the relevance of the clip to the theme

Participants should also submit the following information:

Full name (Surname in bold);

Date of Birth;

A copy of National Identity Card;

A copy of proof of School/Tertiary Institution being attended;

Residential Address;

Email Address;

Telephone/Mobile number.

N.B:

(i) Students under the age of 18 should be authorised to participate by their responsible party and proof of authorisation (letter with signature of Responsible party) should be submitted along with the video clip;

(ii) The video clip would after the competition become the property of the Commission which may use these for public awareness.
